Activities instructors hired for Bay Cliff's Nook Preschool Camp and Bridge Young Adult Camp work in a team that includes Arts and Crafts, Nature, Recreation, Performing Arts, and Aquatics (see Lifeguard job description).

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be:

- dependable and mature.
- positive, enthusiastic, and patient.
- able to work independently.
- an effective problem solver.
- adaptable and flexible.
- attentive to details.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Ability to:

- move safely across uneven surfaces.
- sit/stand for long periods of time.
- transport light to moderate objects short distances.
- lift light objects from one level to another.
- make healthy decisions to promote physical and emotional stamina.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Facilitate high-interest, accessible camp activities that engage campers consisting of children ages 3-5, and young adults ages 18-26.
- Adjust planned activities to accommodate camper interest, or other unanticipated conditions such as inclement weather.
- Ensure counselors have the resources they need to engage in planned activity
- Collaborate with other Activities staff, Therapists, and Counselors.
- Participate in all aspects of camp life which includes but is not limited to: eating three meals a day with campers and staff, engaging in evening/all-camp activities, and providing presence in the units when needed, including afternoon and evening rest periods.
- Keep work areas clean and organized.
- Other duties as assigned by Bay Cliff administration.
